Article 1.

The Competition will be held under the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A, the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland and Appendices 25, 29 and 31 of the Motorsport Ireland Year book and these supplementary Regulations. All Competitors who forward completed Entry Forms agree to be bound by these rules.

Article 2.

(A) The Supplementary Regulations for the Rally are stated by Motorsport Ireland Regulations and Definitions 2010 year Book. Copies of the book can be obtained from Motorsport Ireland, Competitions Department, 34 Dawson Street Dublin 2.

(B) Final Instructions will form an integral part of the Supplementary Regulations.

Article 3.

(A) Entries open on the 21st of April 2010.

(B) Entries will be accepted online or manual (**EVO/rally.connect.ie** or **www.limerickmc.ie**) (Please print off the indemnity, sign and forward with the entry fee) or post the regulations, cheque and signed indemnity to the Entries Secretary: Elaine Higgins, Rahin, Grange, Bruff, Co Limerick

Entry Fee €500, including Personal Accident Insurance and Standard IRDS Insurance.

(C) All drivers must produce a letter of acceptance from one of the IRDS/BRDS

Insurance Schemes.

(D) The Club reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning a reason
Closing Date for entries is on Friday 21st May 2010.

Entries withdrawn in writing after the 21st May will forfeit administration fee of €20.
Entries withdrawn on the weekend of the event (Friday/Sat/Sunday) may be entitled to a part refund at the clubs discretion. (provided the event starts a full field.)

(B) Entries are confined to 141. Should more than 141 fully paid up entries be received, entries

(b) Priorities in **Top Part West Coast Rally Championship** as per Championship Regulations.

(c) Ten at organiser's discretion.

(d) The remainder will be drawn on a ballot.

Class 13 Modified cars 1651cc to 2050cc, 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated with more than 2 valves per cylinder

Class 14 Modified cars 2051cc to 3500cc, 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated or turbo charged. as per Appendix "29"

Class 15 Four-wheel drive whose homologation has expired and other specified cars. See as per Appendix "29"

Class 16 Junior Class Confined to 20 Entries Licences holders under 26 years of age on 01-01-10 driving a car

up to 1650cc. Juniors will compete on Stages 5,6,7 + 8

Class 17a Historic cars up to 1650cc & will compete on Stages 5,6,7 + 8

17b Historic cars over 1650cc & will compete on Stages 5,6,7 + 8
